

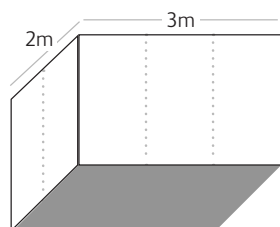
# Higher education exhibitions – stand configurations 2019

## Shell scheme exhibitions

The shell scheme panels are made with high quality, fire retardant nylon loop material, and are manufactured to comply with class 1 fire regulations. They allow for the easy fixing of display items using velcro tape and tabs. The walls are butt-joined panelling 2.44m high and 50mm thick. Please note that 50 – 100mm may be lost from the width of your exhibition stand if you are situated in a block or as part of a row. The name of your organisation and stand number will be displayed to the left of your stand on a tall graphic board, and will be based on the details provided during your online booking.

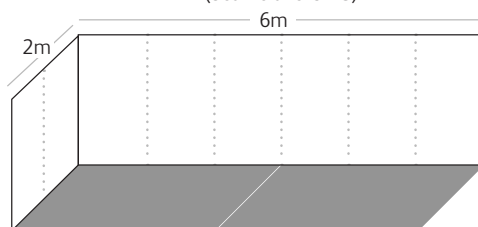
Shell scheme stands can have different wall configurations depending on your location, e.g. if you are at the end of a row, you will be allocated a stand with either a right or left hand wall. If you are in the centre of a row, your stand will have three walls.

### Single stand 3mx2m



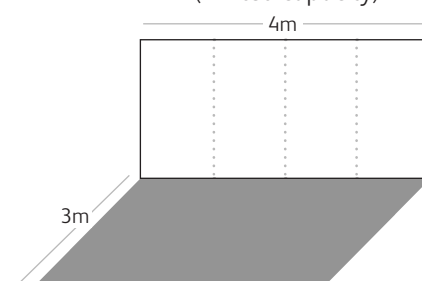
### Double stand 6mx2m

(standard size)

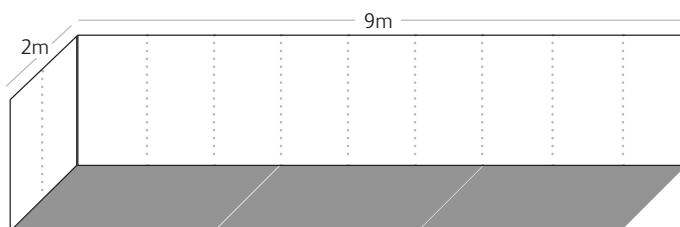


### Double stand 4mx3m

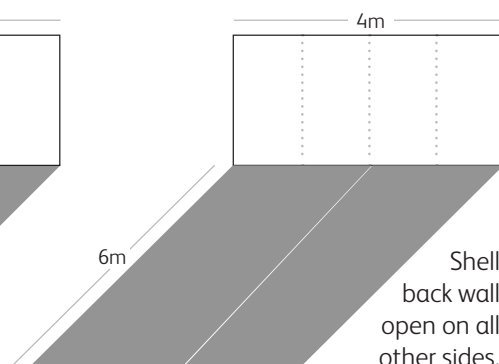
(limited capacity)

### 6mx4m shell



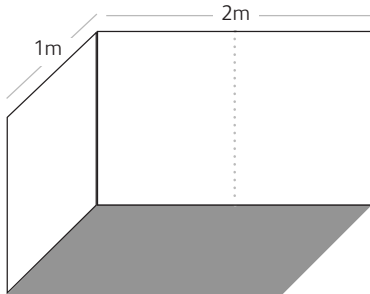
## Space only

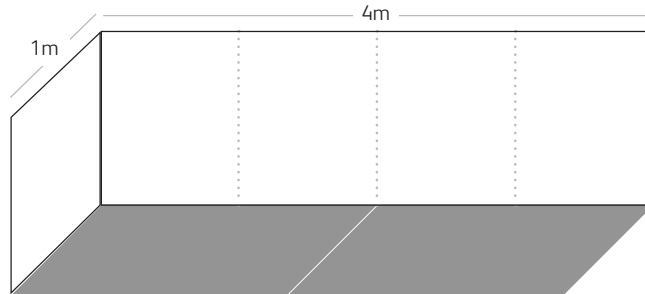
## Campus exhibitions

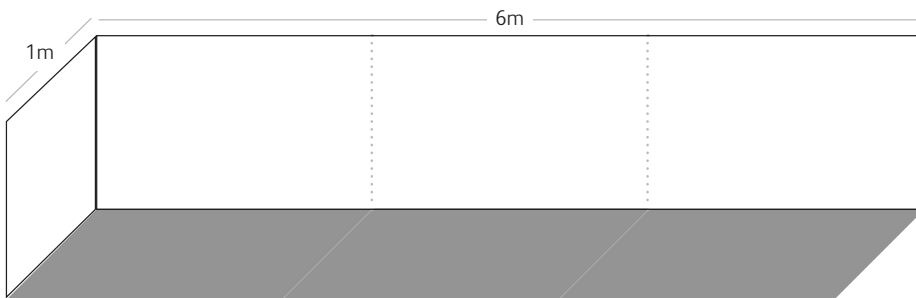
### Single stand 2mx1m
